



# Free Grocery Delivery Service

Schedule a free grocery delivery to your home.

1. Order your groceries online
  - Walmart: [grocery.walmart.com](https://grocery.walmart.com)
  - Target: [grocery.target.com](https://grocery.target.com)
2. Select "Pick-up" option
3. Schedule your pick-up
  - Free delivery is available  
Monday – Friday, 8 am – 6 pm
4. Complete and pay for your order
5. Write down your order number
6. Call Transit Link at 651-602-5465
  - Transit Link is open Monday - Friday, 7 am – 3 pm to schedule your free delivery.
  - You can call up to 4 days in advance or the same-day to arrange your delivery.
  - All deliveries have a 4 bag limit.

Be prepared to provide:

- Your name
- The address where you want the order delivered
- The store and location at which the order was placed
- Your order number
- Your order's scheduled date and pick-up time

In observance of social distancing, Transit Link drivers may not enter apartment buildings to deliver food packs.
